

Privacy Policy pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR)

This privacy policy is provided in accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (“GDPR”) and concerns the processing of personal data collected through this website by the Il Tricheco Blu Foundation.

1. Data Controller

2. Types of Data collected

Through this website, the following personal data may be collected:

- First and last name
- Email address
- Personal and tax data necessary for issuing receipts (e.g., tax code, VAT number, address)
- Information related to donations (amount, date, payment method)
- Any message content submitted via the contact form

3. Purpose of processing

Your data will be processed for the following purposes:

- a) To respond to contact requests submitted via the website form (legal basis: consent – Art. 6, para. 1, lett. a GDPR);
- b) To send institutional communications, newsletters, project updates, event invitations, and other Foundation-related activities, with the user’s explicit consent (legal basis: consent – Art. 6, para. 1, lett. a GDPR);
- c) To manage received donations and comply with administrative, accounting, and tax obligations, including issuing receipts and documents required by law (legal basis: legal obligation – Art. 6, para. 1, lett. c GDPR).

4. Methods of processing

Data processing is carried out using electronic tools and, in some cases, manually. Processing is performed by authorized and trained personnel, in accordance with technical and organizational measures to ensure the security, confidentiality, and integrity of the data.

5. Nature of data provision

- Providing data for the purposes outlined in point (a) is optional, but necessary to receive a response.
- Consent for newsletter subscription (point b) is optional, and failure to provide it does not affect the ability to submit a contact request.
- Providing data for accounting and tax purposes (point c) is mandatory to fulfill legal obligations; without such data, it will not be possible to issue valid tax receipts.

6. Data retention

- Data collected for contact purposes (a) will be retained for **up to 12 months**.
- Data collected for newsletter purposes (b) will be retained until consent is withdrawn, which may be done at any time.
- Data collected for accounting and tax purposes (c) will be retained for the period required by law, generally 10 years, as established by the Civil Code and tax regulations.

7. Data communication and disclosure

Data may be disclosed to:

- Tax or legal consultants
- Technical and IT service providers (e.g., email platforms, CRM systems, hosting providers)
- Public entities or authorities, only in cases required by law

All third parties are bound by specific contracts and act as data processors pursuant to Article 28 of the GDPR.

Data will not be disclosed or transferred outside the European Union, except in compliance with Articles 44 and following of the GDPR.

8. Data subject rights

You may exercise your rights at any time under Articles 15–22 of the GDPR, including:

- Access to your data
- Rectification, erasure, or restriction of processing
- Objection to processing
- Withdrawal of consent (for processing based on consent)
- Data portability
